AWARD

Upon providing both parties with an opportunity to be heard, having ascertained his jurisdiction and considered the factual and legal arguments as well as the requests for relief submitted in this case, the Arbitrator decides as follows:

- 1. MTÜ Valga Korvpallikool shall pay Mr. Sasa Djordjevic an amount of EUR 12,500.00 as compensation for unpaid remuneration under the contract dated 13 March 2013, plus interest at 5% per annum on such amount from 17 October 2013 onwards.**
- 2. MTÜ Valga Korvpallikool shall pay Mr. Goran Kosanin an amount of EUR 1,500.00 as compensation for unpaid remuneration under the contract dated 13 March 2013, plus interest at 5% per annum on such amount from 17 October 2013 onwards.**
- 3. The costs of this arbitration until the present Award, which were determined by the President of the BAT to be in the amount of EUR 5,274.00, shall be borne by MTÜ Valga Korvpallikool alone. Accordingly, MTÜ Valga Korvpallikool shall pay jointly to Mr. Sasa Djordjevic and Mr. Goran Kosanin EUR 5,274.00.**
- 4. MTÜ Valga Korvpallikool shall pay jointly to Mr. Sasa Djordjevic and Mr. Goran Kosanin an amount of EUR 1,500.00 as compensation for their legal fees and expenses.**
- 5. Any arbitration costs associated with a Request for Reasons (see attached Notice) shall be advanced and borne by the requesting party.**
- 6. Any other or further-reaching requests for relief are dismissed.**

Notice about Request for Reasons

in accordance with Article 16.2 of the BAT Rules:

“By agreeing to submit their dispute to arbitration under these Rules, the Parties agree that, where the value of the dispute does not exceed EUR 30,000, the Arbitrator will issue an award without reasons. The Arbitrator shall deliver reasons only in the case where a party

- a) files a request to that effect at any stage from when the Request for Arbitration is filed until no later than ten (10) days after the notification of the award without reasons; and*
- b) pays the respective advance on costs as determined and within the time limit set by the BAT Secretariat.”*

On 7 January 2014 the BAT Secretariat informed the Parties that the amount of the advance on costs to be paid for a reasoned award in this case is EUR 5,000. The time limit for payment thereof shall be set by the BAT Secretariat upon receipt of the Request for Reasons, if any.
